Key responsibilities and accountabilities:	 Travel to local consignment yards and collect slings that need to be recertified or replaced Drop slings off at designated vendor sites and retrieve once the client is finished using them Verify the sling tags and certifications match before leaving the vendor's office Achieve NDT certification to carry out magnetic particle inspections (MPI) on designated equipment Carry out required maintenance on all units, including but not limited to: Check straps and replacing if, needed Install new GPS units and logging the correct GPS number Replace old OEG stickers while performing outer maintenance Double-check all ratchets to ensure they are working properly and replacing, if necessary Use a wire-wheel to grind off any rust, then apply a galvanize spray to prevent future rust Assist OEG's local logistics partner on all OEG-related activities, most often unloading equipment
Health and Safety Responsibilities	Health and safety of all staff under direct control or supervision. Ensure all activities are carried out in a safe manner in line with current risk assessments and good working practices. Ensure accident/incidents are reported in a timely manner. Comply with OEG Offshore Group HSE policy.
Quality Responsibilities	To have a general understanding of the areas of our ISO 9001 management system that are relevant to the role, comply with our OEG Group Quality Policy and understand OEG's targets and objectives.
